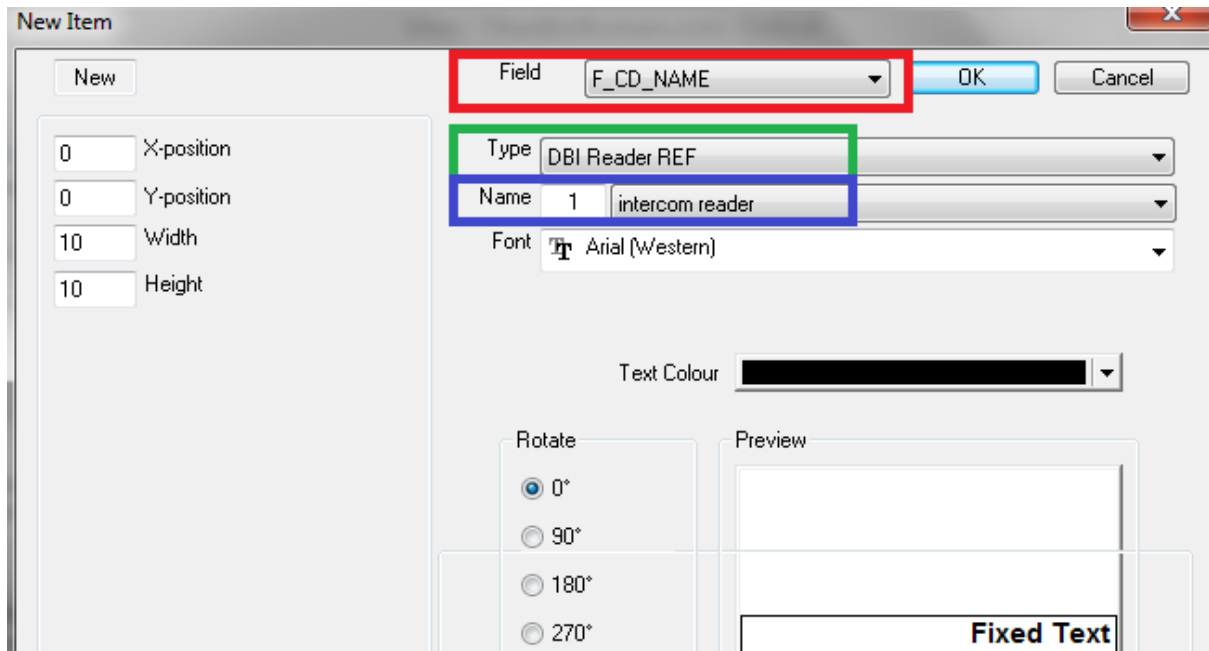
Name/ Surname.

Make the "type" DBI Reader REF.

In the "Name" field choose the reader that you are going to badge to get the information.

At the top, in "field" drop down box, specify what you want to display, name, surname, ect.

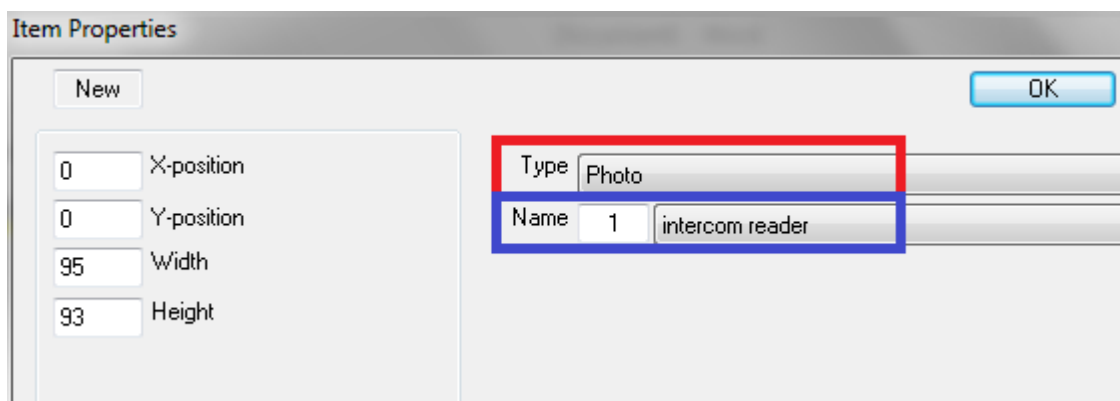
Click ok and make the picture bigger.

The "Type" you choose Photo.

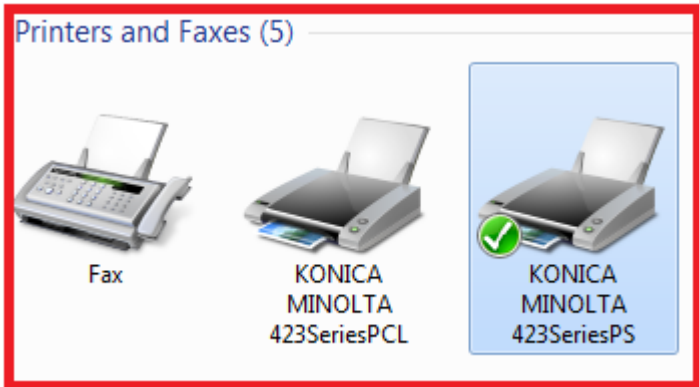
The name field is the reader



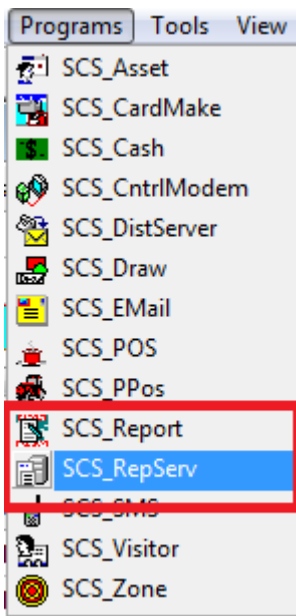
Print with SCS_Draw

Install the printer drivers onto the computer you going to print from.

Make that printer the default printer on that computer.



Open the scs_Repserv and the scs_report.



In SCS_Report click on setup, setup editor. In Report printers make sure you use xref 1 and not xref 0. Choose the printer you will be using to print too.

Click setup, setup editor and then system printers. In the driver name you go and copy the printers name out of printers and devices, and then past it in there. Choose the printer xref like you have done in Report Printers. Then the pc name must be inserted in the pc name field. Make sure that you use xref 1 and not xref 0.

In scs_Report click on setup, and then set-up report.

In the field called Report name, you can either search for the specific report that you need by clicking on the dropdown box, or typing in the report reference.

I'm using report 45 because it's the most common report to pull.

On report 45 there where "report to" is, insert PRINT.

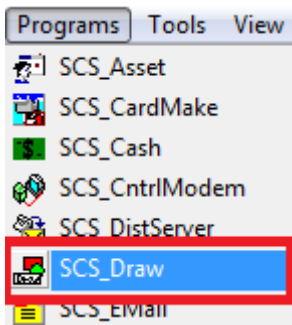

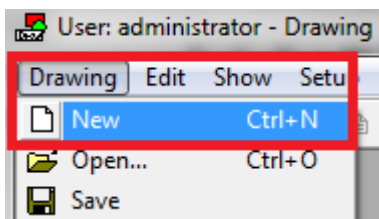

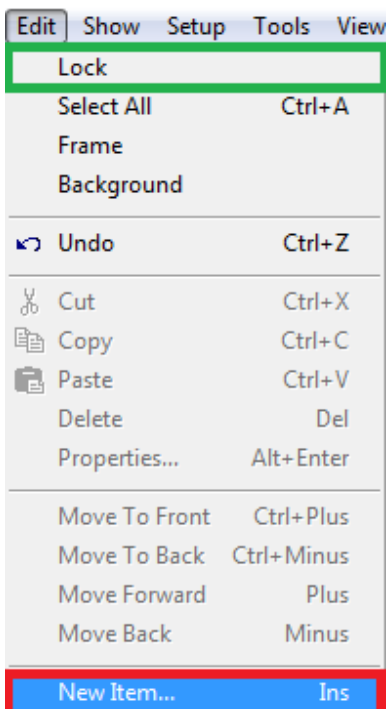
Open SCS_Draw.



Open a new drawing by clicking on Drawing and then New.



Click on edit and then unlock. Then edit again and New Item.



Dropdown box and then choose EXEBUTTON.

In the upper most left corner of the New Item box type in this path.

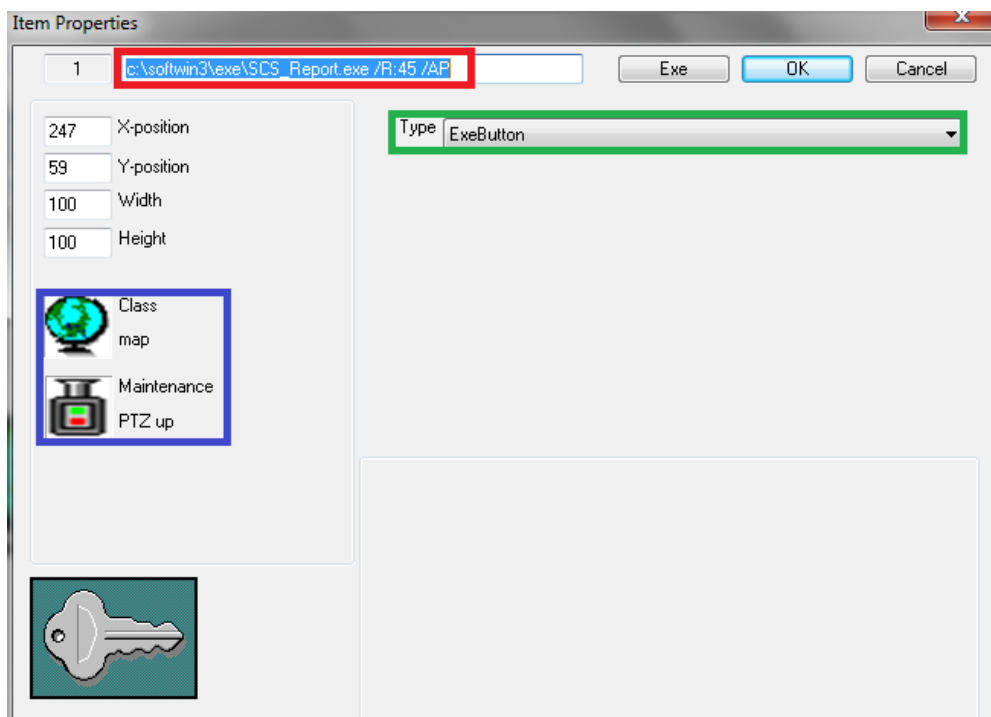
c:\softwin3\exe\SCS_Report.exe /R:45 /AP

the "c:\softwin3\exe\SCS_Report.exe" is what .exe to open.

The "/R:45" is what report you want to open.

The "/AP" is the Auto Print function.

In "CLASS" and "MAINTENACE" you can insert the pictures you want to be displayed for the button.



When finished click on OK.

Click on Edit and lock your drawing.

Click on your picture, the report will print.

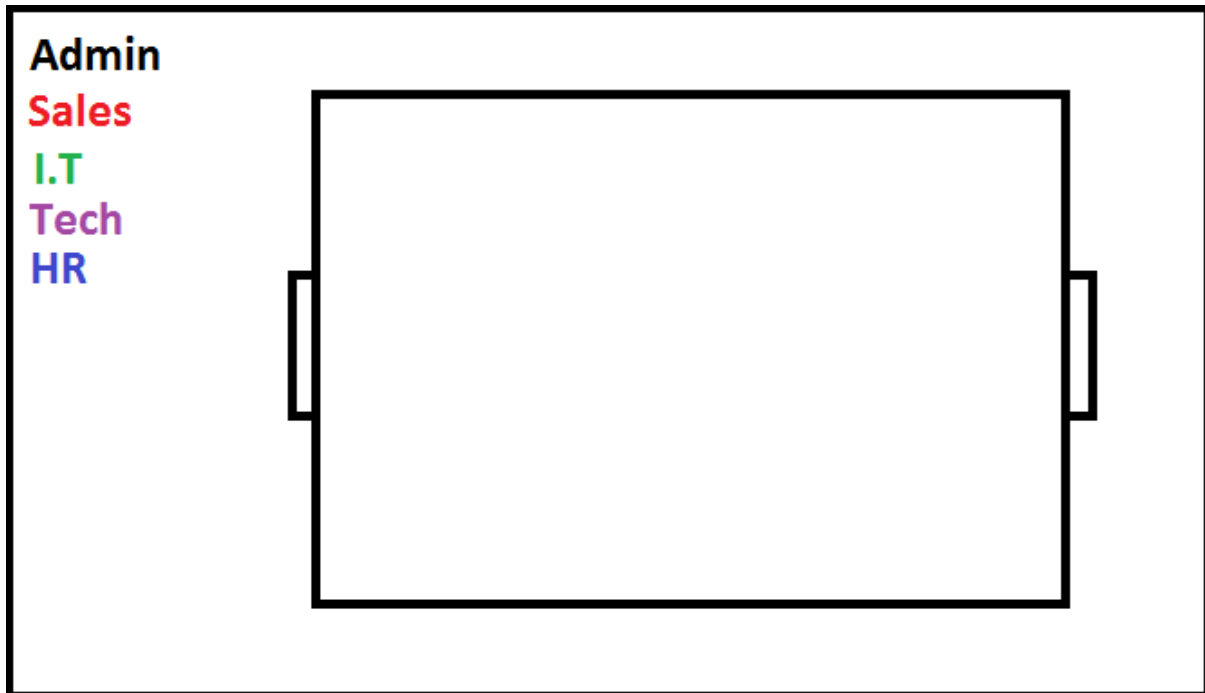

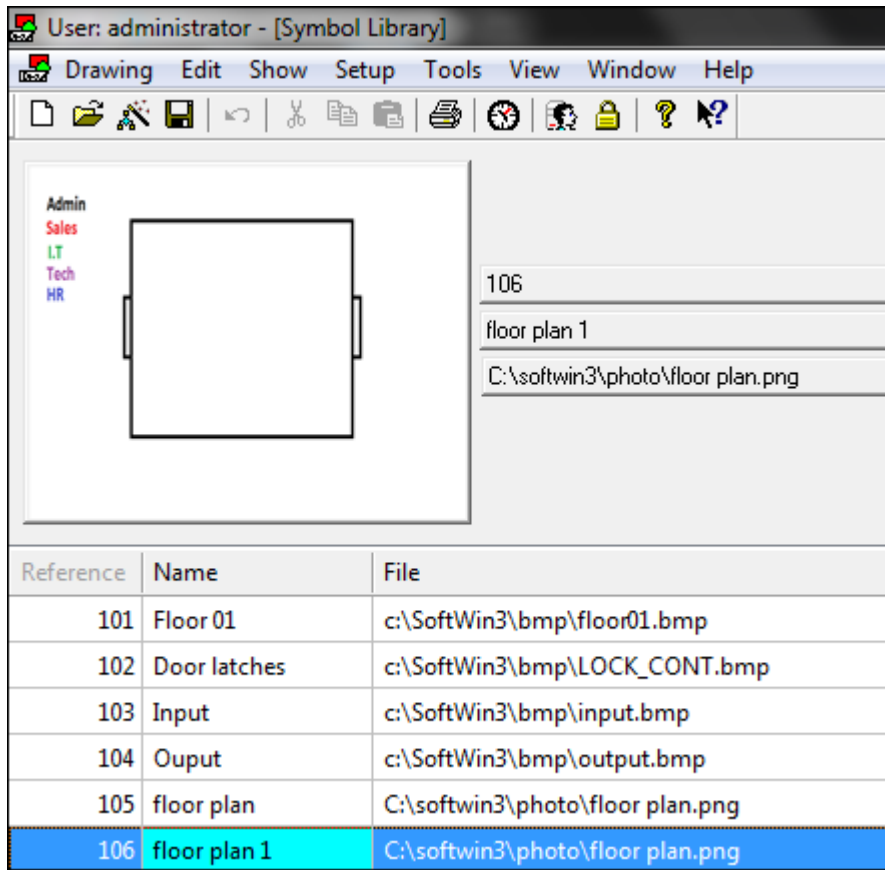

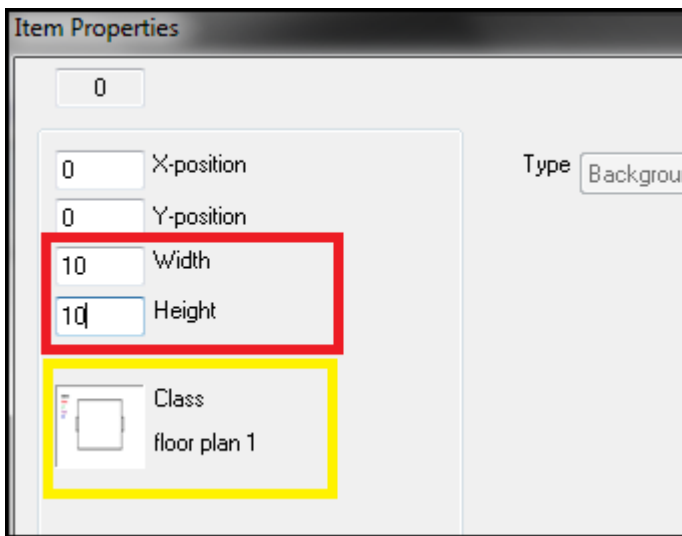


Name: Description of the drawing.

File: Browse to that specific folder you have saved the drawing you've made with paint.

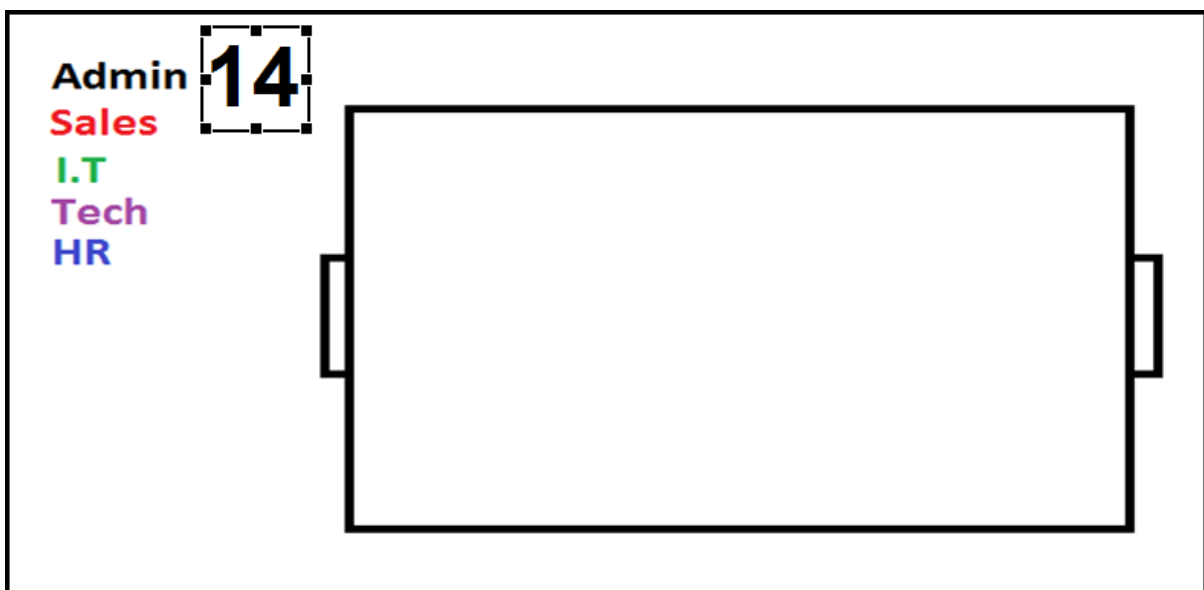
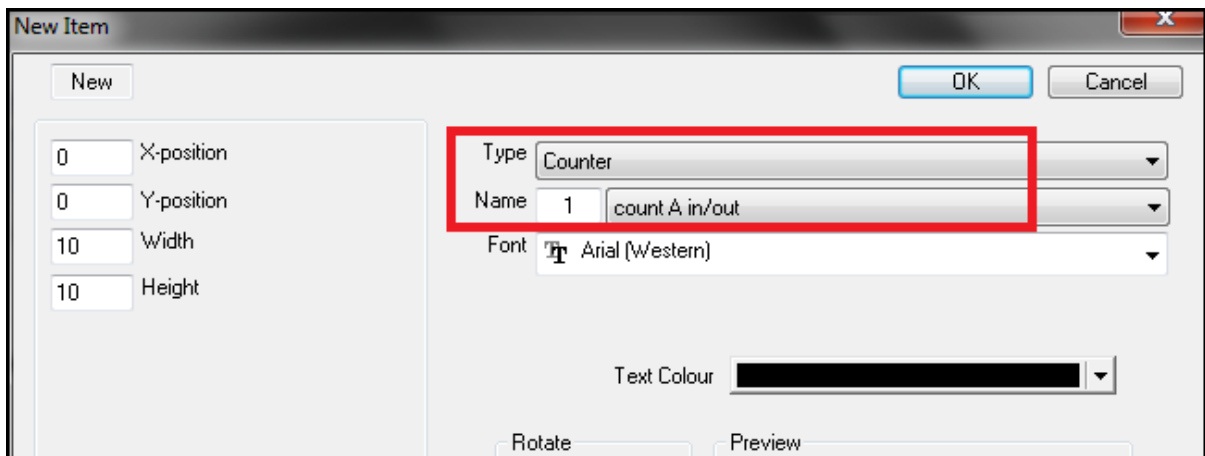
Pull in drawing into SCS_draw
